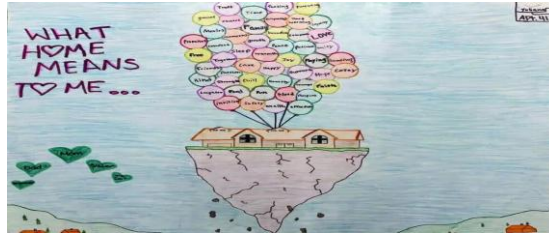

### Flower Bed Policy



We love seeing residents add flowers and plants to brighten up our community! Just a reminder that all flower beds must be approved by THA management, including any existing beds.

Flower beds may be placed in front of or behind your building and can extend up to three feet from the building. Please be sure all beds have approved edging and are kept neat and weed-free.

#### A few quick reminders:

- Plants must stay inside the flower bed and not touch the building
- Keep plants trimmed below window level
- No trees, and keep plants 4 feet away from A/C units
- Store gardening tools inside your home
- Remove summer plants and decorations by December 1

Flower beds are maintained at your own risk, and those that don't follow the guidelines may be removed and could result in a lease violation.

**RECOMMENDED MAINTENANCE TO PREVENT PEST**
