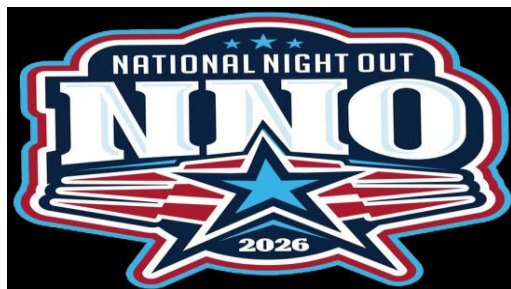

### ***“Maintenance Matters” Summer Cooling Tips!***

As temperatures climb, so do utility bills. The following tips  
will help lower utility bills and stay cool.

- 1) Keep all windows and exterior doors closed
- 2) Set thermostats to a steady temperature
- 3) Raise the temperature setting a few degrees while away
- 4) Do not turn off while you're away, the unit will work harder when you turn it back on. Doing this may cause it to freeze up and stop working
- 5) Use fans
- 6) Avoid cooking during the hottest times of the day

### **Effective September 1, 2026**

The revised maintenance charge schedule is posted in the lobby at each office. Please call the office with any questions or comments.

**Standard light bulbs will no longer be provided, except at move in, (all fluorescent bulbs and specialty bulbs at Timber Ridge will be replaced at no charge).**

**Beginning September 1, 2026 only the following items will be considered an emergency that maintenance will respond to within 24 hours.**

1. No heat when outside temperature is below 55 degrees.
2. No air conditioning when outside temperature is above 85 degrees.
3. Smoke alarm is beeping or not working.
4. Total outage of refrigerator (calls after 10:00pm will be serviced next business day).
5. Stove not working (calls after 10:00pm will be serviced next business day).
6. Toilet stopped up, when only one in apartment.
7. Major plumbing backups and/or conditions might cause harm to the tenant and/or damage to the property (includes uncontrollable overflowing toilet and other exposure to raw sewage).
8. Water leak flooding unit
9. Power outage in unit (if housing authority is responsible)
10. Fire (call 911)
11. Exposed electrical wires
12. Gas leaks
13. No water (if housing authority is responsible)
14. Natural Disaster (roof or apartment damage)
